





The Border Church Operation Report

November 2020

We are very proud of the effort to provide Holistic Attention to Migrants and Deported

Persons, in the continuous support that is carried out in Tijuana, as a strong arm that creates bridges of hope.

Because of the COVID pandemic, the suspended immigration services, Courts, and the border closed, the migrant community and the Shelter Directors decided to "stay at home" in late March and early April.





In the same way, the closure of the offices of the Border Church in Tijuana was presented, since we helped migrants and deportees who went to Garita del Chaparral and when it closed,

they no longer attended this area.

The office was reopened when we

realized that there is a large community of migrants and deportees, who found a place to live outside the shelters, since they managed to obtain a job by becoming residents of Tijuana.





While this was happening, and to continue providing adequate care, a *Virtual*

Attention Program was created, which would allow the



entry of Lawyers, Counseling and English Classes, and soon Computer Classes.















However, since there were no computers for digital comunication, the **Shelter Computer** Center Installation Project was born and soon the resource for the first Shelter arrived, while our Office continued to adapt to the circumstances. Currently, Computer Rooms have been installed in the "Embajadores de Jesus Shelter" (electrical and furniture) "Roca de Salvación Shelter" (Doors, Electrical, Furniture, and Equipment) and our offices. (Furniture and Equipment).


Border Church Virtual Hike and Sunday Service
